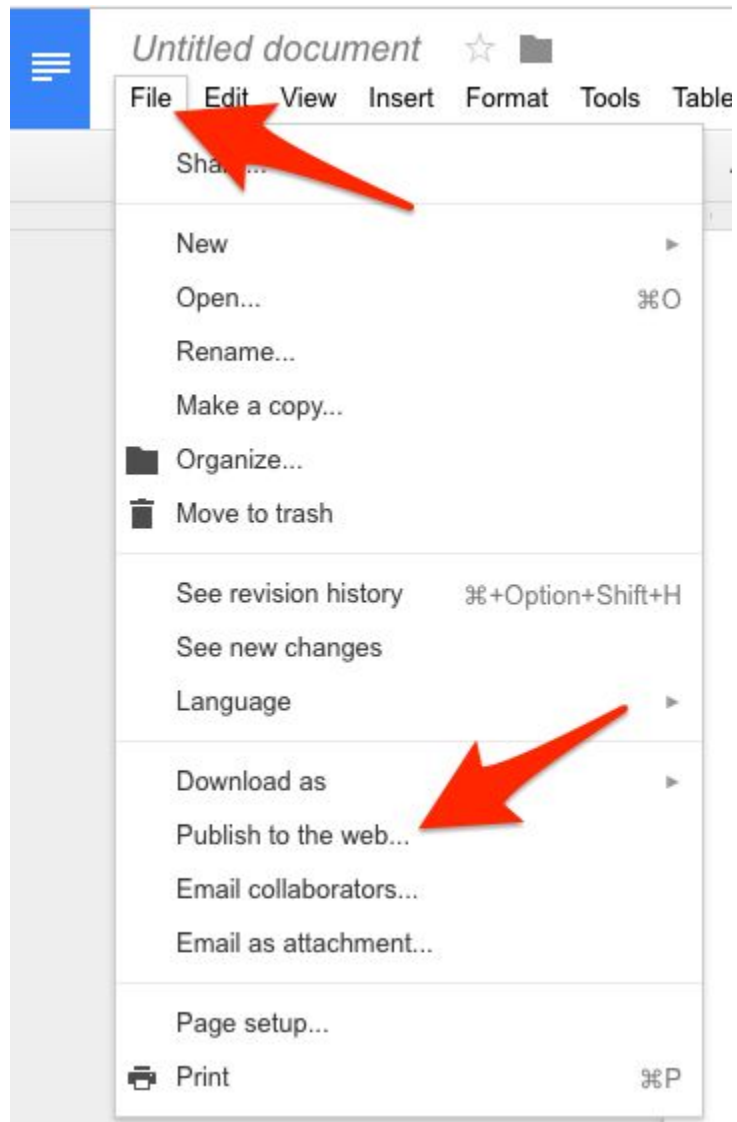


# Google Docs Embed 1.0 for IPS4

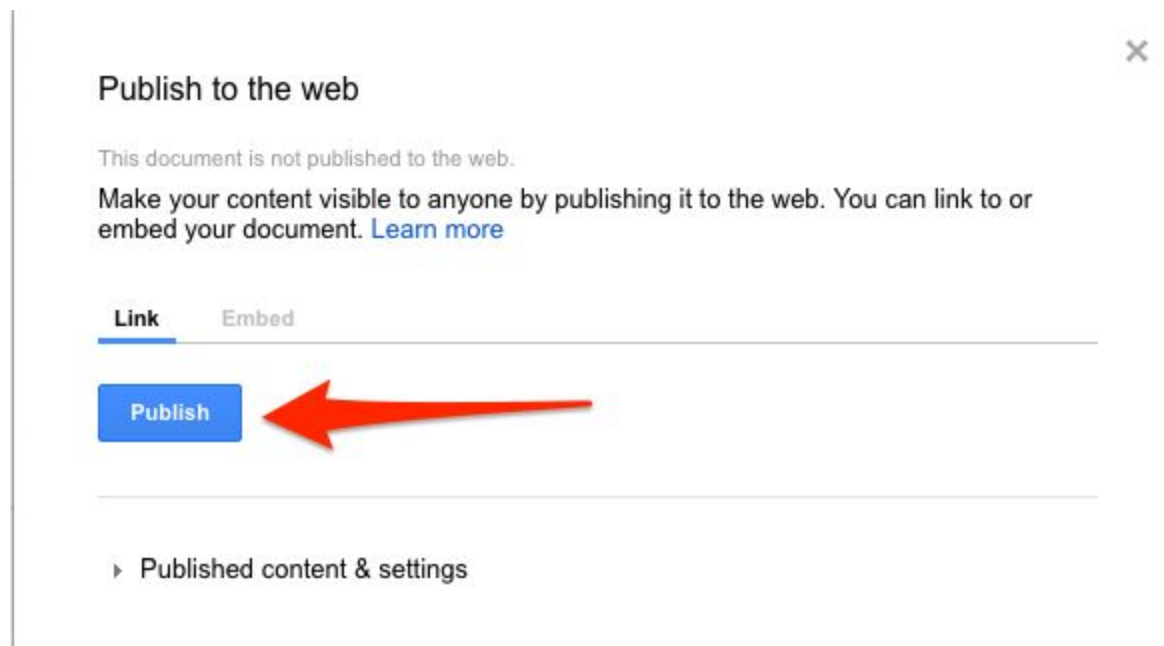
## Usage instructions


